About the role

As a Compass ELC Site Lead you will work as a Registered Early Childhood Educator alongside some of the most passionate, caring, and dedicated educators in the industry. You will spend your time engaging, connecting, and learning alongside children, families, and co-educators, as well as ensuring licensing standards are met and Compass ELC values are evident in all aspects of the program. You will model and grow an equity perspective and strive for a deeper understanding of cultural awareness.

As a Site Lead for our school-age programs, for 25 hours a week, you must be available both before school (7-9 am) and after school (3-6 pm) Monday to Friday. You will also be expected to work an additional 10 hours a week in our administration office for administrative tasks, documentation, and pedagogy. There is the possibility of continued full-time hours over school holidays including March Break, Summer, and P.D. days.

Compass ELC Woodville offers a large, and diverse outdoor environment. The outdoor space has a major impact on the program. We have found ways to adapt our routine, to spend as much time as possible in our beautiful outdoor space. Working in a rural school with a small population means provides you with the opportunity to form connections within the school by becoming familiar with the school staff and growing a partnership with them through daily interactions.

- Responsible for billing, accounts receivables, enrollments, managing child care waitlist.
- Ensuring that the program is meeting the requirements set out by licensing as per the Child Care Early Years Act, and in line with How Does Learning Happen, Ontario's Pedagogy for the Early Years.
- Welcoming and training new staff into your program, including supply staff
- Planning and implementing play-based experiences following observations made children's interests.
